You must complete the admission form which requires your typed bar number, typed name, and signature, the date you were admitted to the Superior Court and the County in which that Court is located, and the endorsements (**signatures**) of **two attorneys who are members of the bar of this Court**. The fee for admission is \$30.00.

Please **bring** your admission application and fee to the Court on the day you wish to be admitted. A personal check or exact cash for the fee is acceptable. You may be administered the oath on any day the Court is scheduled for oral argument. You should report to the Clerk's office (47 Trinity Avenue, S. W., Suite 501) no later than 9:20 a.m. on that day. The oral argument schedule is located on the calendar page of this web site.

In the alternative, on a walk-in basis, you may appear between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and noon on Tuesdays or Thursdays at the Clerk's Office with your application and admission fee. A Judge of the Court, if a judge is available, the Clerk, Deputy Clerk or Deputy Administrator will administer the oath to you.
