



How to Connect to the GA Court of Appeals VPN (Step-by-Step Guide)

This guide will show you how to securely connect to the Georgia Court of Appeals network (gajudicial) using the **Sophos Connect VPN**. Don't worry – we'll walk you through each step in a simple, easy-to-follow way!

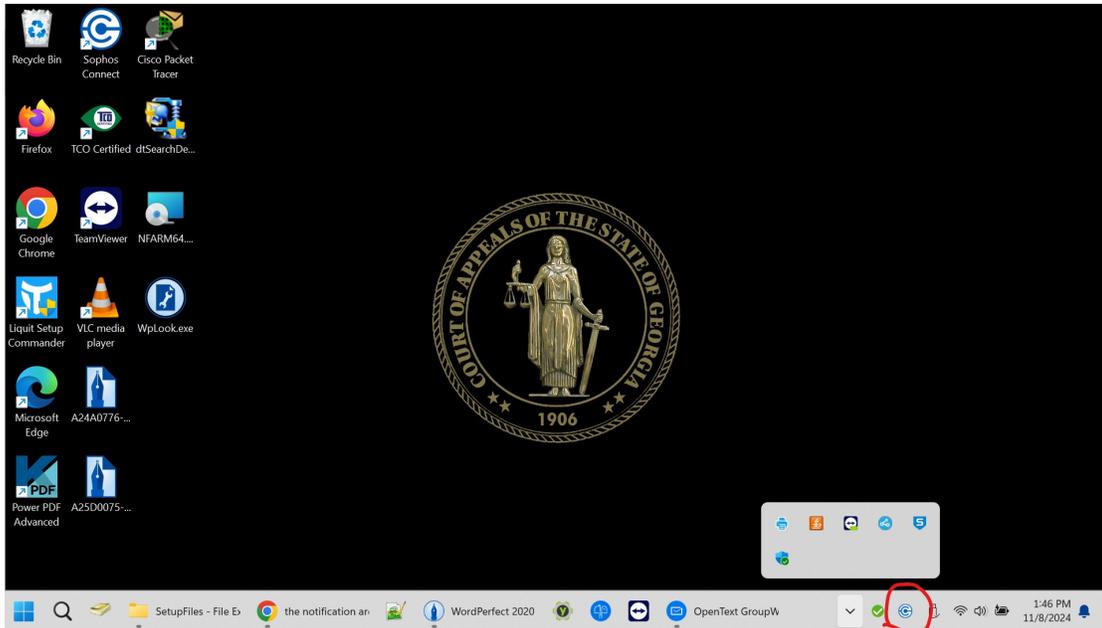
What You Need:

Sophos Connect: This is the VPN app that helps you connect to the GA Court of Appeals network safely and securely.



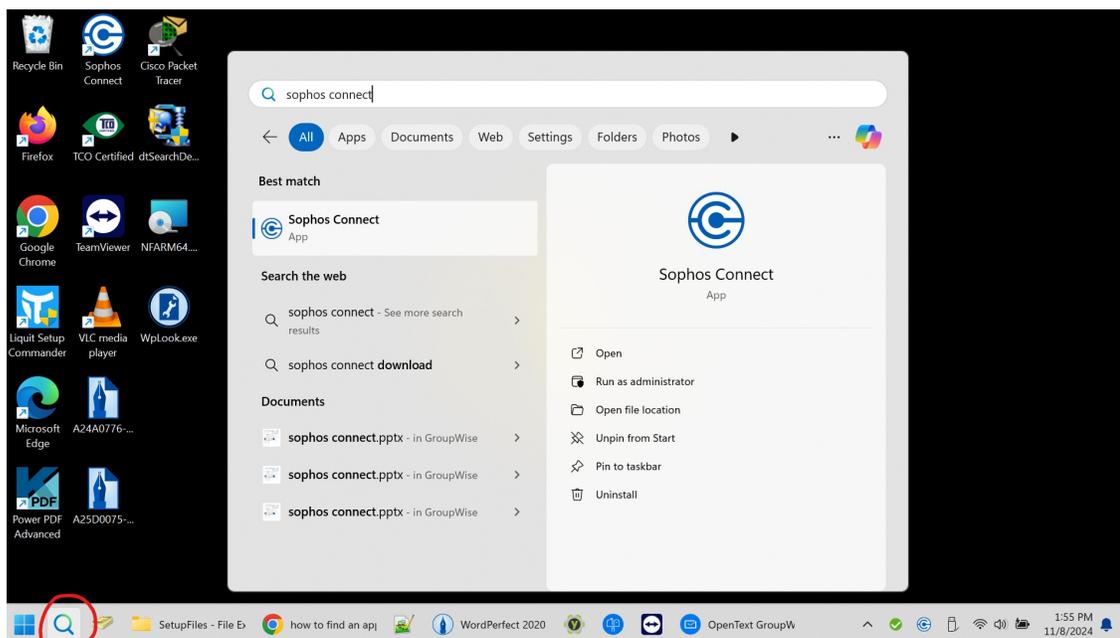
Step 1: Open the Sophos Connect App

- Look for the **Sophos Connect** icon in your **notification center** (this is on the right side of your taskbar at the bottom of the screen). It might look like a small icon with a shield or a lock.



If you don't see it there:

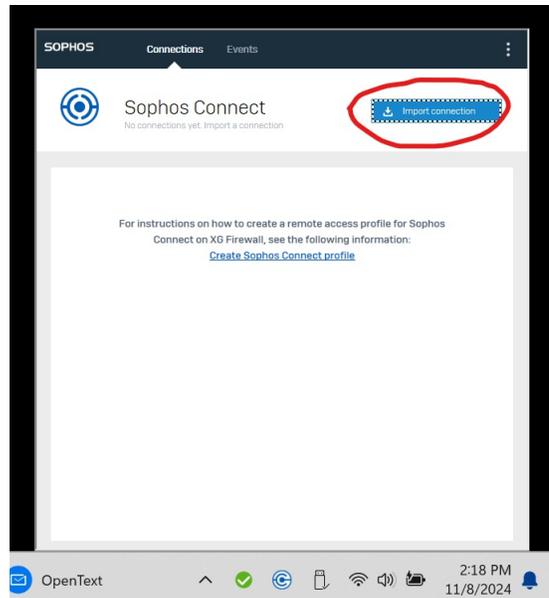
- Click the **Windows search** icon (the magnifying glass in the bottom-left corner of your screen).
- Type “**Sophos Connect**” in the search bar and click on the app to open it.



Step 2: Import the Connection File (First Time Only)

- If this is your first time using the Sophos Connect app, you may need to **import the VPN connection file**. This is an important step for establishing a secure connection.

You might see a message asking you to **import a file**. Don't worry – this is normal.



What to do:

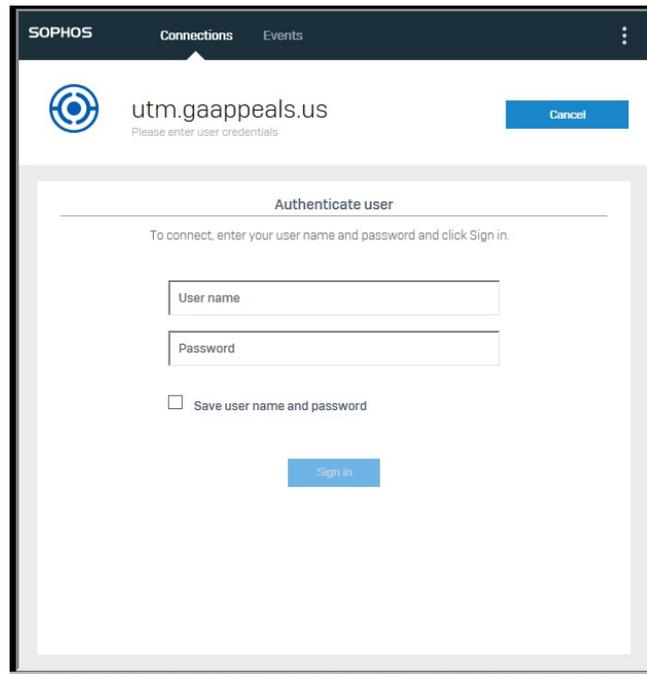
- If you see this message, contact IT to get the **vpn.pro connection file**.
- Alternatively, the connection file may already be on your computer!
Look in this folder:
C:\SetupFiles\Software\Sophos VPN Client.
- If you find the file, you can manually import it into the app.

Step 3: Login to the VPN

- Once the connection file is imported, you'll see the **login screen**.

What to do:

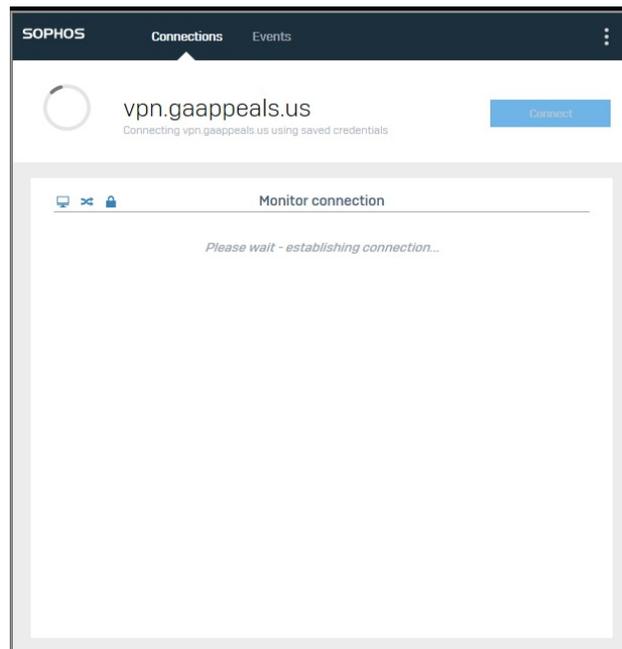
- Enter your **username and password**.
- If you want the app to remember your login details so you don't have to enter them each time, check the box that says "**Save username and password**".



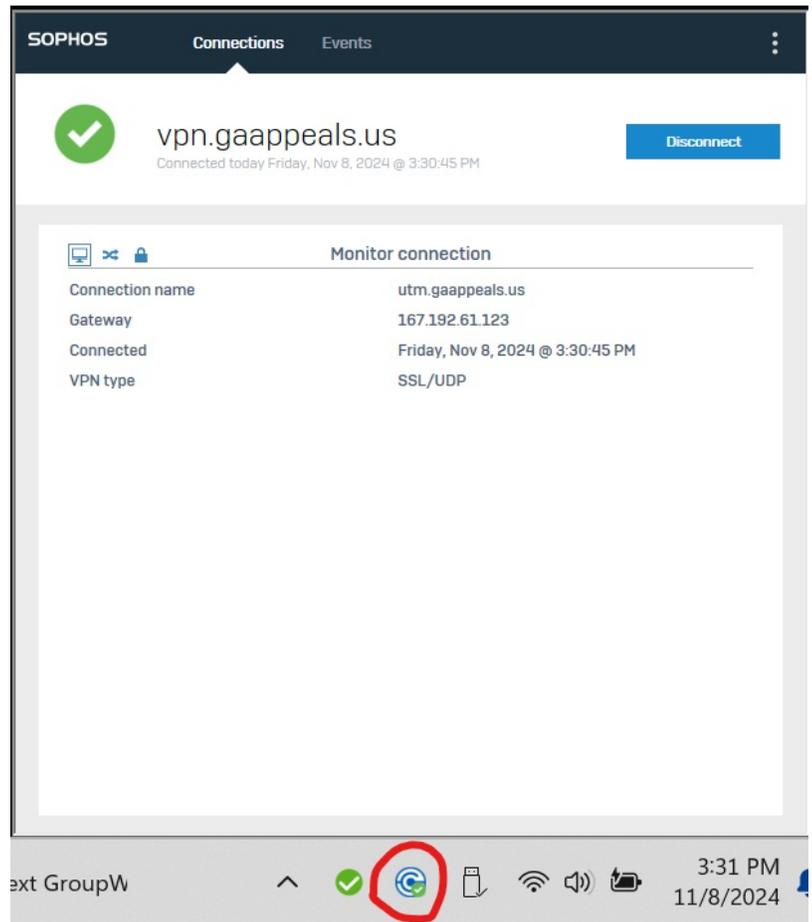
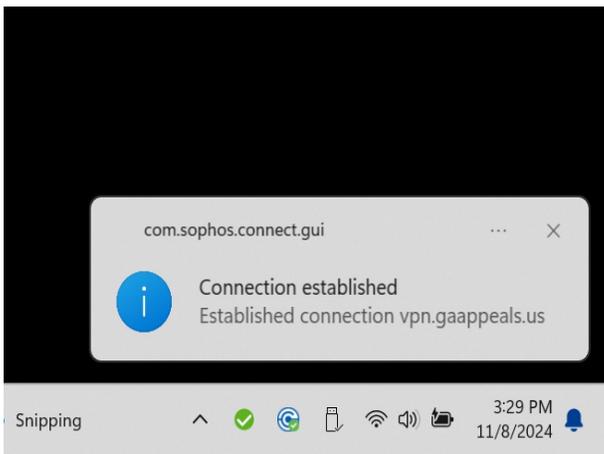
- Click **Sign In** to start the connection.

Step 4: Wait for the Connection to Establish

- After you click **Sign In**, the VPN app will start connecting. You might see a **loading circle** for a few seconds.



Once the connection is successful, you'll see a **green check mark** confirming you're connected.



Step 5: You're Ready to Go!

- You've now successfully connected to the **Georgia Court of Appeals** network using the VPN.
- This connection is important if you need to:
 - Access internal network folders
 - Run macros that use network folders within Word Perfect
 - Use other internal resources at the Court of Appeals
