I am voting to grant these applications in order to look into the premises liability issue more closely. It may be that I will dismiss them as improvidently granted; however, at first glance, it is difficult to find any negligence, at least on the part of the homeowner.

After a preliminary reading, the evidence shows that the homeowner did not even know that Sidre was home alone instead of at day care, much less that he had a friend over. I do not believe the homeowner was negligent just because there were matches in the house; nor do I believe that the "attractive nuisance" doctrine is applicable in this case. Therefore, I would grant both applications. Please have the case transferred to me.
