ATLANTA, September 26, 1995

The Honorable Court of Appeals met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

A95A1770. MARTIN v. THE STATE

It appearing that the trial counsel is not available to prosecute this appeal, that appellant is not desirous of representing himself and may be indigent, and that the time for filing the enumeration of errors and brief would have expired on May 30 but for the prisoner appellant's request for assistance, and

It further appearing that an extension of time may not resolve the problem,

It is therefore ORDERED that the case is remanded to the trial court for appointment of counsel to prosecute the appeal if the trial court finds that defendant is entitled to court-appointed counsel.

It is further ORDERED that upon entry of the trial court's order on the issue, the case shall be transmitted to this Court and redocketed on the original notice of appeal.
