*The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:*

## **A10A0750. HOGGES v. IT'S LEAKING AGAIN ROOFING.**

It's Leaking Again Roofing ("ILA Roofing") sued Sharon Hogges for the balance due under a contract. Following a bench trial, the trial court awarded ILA Roofing \$5,095.11. Hogges then filed a notice of direct appeal.

We lack jurisdiction. Where, as here, the total judgment is \$10,000 or less, the aggrieved party must follow the discretionary appeal procedures in OCGA § 5-6-35. See OCGA § 5-6-35 (a) (6). Hogges's failure to comply with these procedures deprives us of jurisdiction over her appeal, which is hereby DISMISSED. See *Hill v. Rose Electric Co.*, 220 Ga. App. 603 (469 SE2d 844) (1996); *Klobe v. Montgomery Ward & Co.*, 178 Ga. App. 164 (342 SE2d 496) (1986).

## **A10A0778. GRAHAM v. WELLS FARGO BANK, N.A.**
