The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:

A98A2449. ALTERNATIVE HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS v. MCCOWN.

Appellee has moved the court for an "Expedited Ruling" in this case. Such motions are not looked upon with favor, both because the Georgia Constitution requires that all appeals before this court and the Supreme Court must be decided within two terms, and because there are certain categories of cases, such as criminal appeals involving an appellant who is incarcerated, that are required to be expedited by statute. This appeal, like all others, will be decided as expeditiously as possible, consistent with the court's constitutional and statutory obligations and the demands of its caseload.
