*The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:*

**A00A0987. KETCHUP v. HOWARD.**

On November 29, 2000, this Court entered a decision in the above-styled case. The parties to the case in both the trial court and this Court were Joseph Ketchup and Dr. A. J. Howard. Those two parties had until December 11, 2000 to file a motion for reconsideration. Neither did, and the time for doing so having expired, this Court would be without jurisdiction to consider any motion for reconsideration which either Ketchup or Howard now filed.

On December 11, 2000, certain non-party individuals and a non-party corporation filed a motion seeking to intervene in this case for purposes of pursuing a petition for certiorari and a motion for reconsideration in this Court. There being no legal basis to allow non-parties to intervene at the appellate level when they have no relationship to the litigation, did not seek to intervene in the trial court, and did not seek to intervene in the appellate court prior to the disposition of the case being announced, their motion is dismissed.
