The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:

A00A1051. H. J. RUSSELL & COMPANY v. REGINA JONES

Appellant filed its notice of appeal in this case without stating that a trial transcript should be transmitted as part of the record on appeal, as required by OCGA § 5-6-37. As a result, the appeal was docketed in this court in accordance with OCGA § 5-6-43 without the transcript being made part of the appellate record. Appellant has now filed a motion in this court to supplement the record with the trial transcript. Appellant states in its motion that a complete trial transcript has not yet been prepared. Under the circumstances, we must remand the case to the trial court for determination of whether appellant should be granted an extension of time for filing the transcript. See OCGA § 5-6-42.
