*The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:*

**A05A0758. JEROME JACKSON, SR. v. DAVID OLSON, ET AL.**

On January 14, 2005, this Court issued an order dismissing the above appeal. Thereafter, on February 18, 2005, Jerome Jackson, Sr. filed an Application for Writ of Certiorari in the Supreme Court of Georgia denominated as S05C0914.

On May 20, 2005, appellant Jackson filed a Motion to Stay Remittitur. The Application for Writ of Certiorari is still pending in the Supreme Court of Georgia, and therefore, the remittitur will be stayed. Should the Supreme Court of Georgia deny the Application for Writ of Certiorari, then this Court will issue its remittitur *instanta*.

Should appellant Jackson wish to stay the remittitur on a possible Application for Certiorari in the Supreme Court of the United States, he would need to file such a motion to stay with the Supreme Court of the United States. Since the Application for Writ of Certiorari is pending in the Supreme Court of Georgia, this Court does not have jurisdiction to review the Motion to Stay the Remittitur, and it is therefore **DISMISSED**.
