The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:

**A00A0120. Time Warner Entertainment Company, LP, et al. v. Six
Flags over Georgia, LLC, et al.**

On July 13, 2000, this Court issued an opinion affirming the judgment of the trial court. Thereafter, on August 16, 2000, the appellants filed an application for certiorari with the Supreme Court of Georgia, which application was denied on January 18, 2001. On February 16, 2001, appellants filed a Notice of Intent to Apply for Certiorari to the United States Supreme Court and a Motion to Stay the Remittitur. This Court denied the Motion to Stay the Remittitur on February 20, 2001, and issued the remittitur that same day.

On March 1, 2001, the United States Supreme Court issued an order directing the remittitur of the Court of Appeals of Georgia in the above appeal be stayed pending the timely filing of an application for certiorari to the United States Supreme Court and the disposition of such application. The order was received in the Court of Appeals of Georgia on March 5, 2001, and pursuant to the order of the United States Supreme Court, it is hereby ordered that the remittitur in the above appeal is hereby RECALLED and shall remain in the Court of Appeals of Georgia until the Petition for Writ of Certiorari be denied by the United States Supreme Court and this Court is notified of that fact by the United States Supreme Court, or until such other order of the United States Supreme Court issues directing the Court of Appeals of Georgia to issue its remittitur.
