The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

It is ordered that the Rules of the Supreme Court of Georgia be hereby amended by striking Rule 28 in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

**RULE 28. REQUIREMENTS.** Compliance with the requirements of this rule governing petitions for certiorari is mandatory.

(1) Notice of intention to apply for certiorari shall be given the Clerk of the Court of Appeals within 10 days after judgment or the order overruling the motion for reconsideration, if one is filed. Do not file a copy of the notice of intent in the Supreme Court.

(2) The petition for certiorari shall be filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court within twenty (20) days after the judgment or the order overruling the motion for reconsideration, if one is filed, along with payment of costs when required by Rule 11.

This rule shall be effective <sup>January 1, 1995.</sup> ~~August~~ 1, 1994.

## **61. ORDER AMENDING RULES.**

It is ordered that the Rules of the Supreme Court of Georgia be hereby amended by striking Rule 28 in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:
