## **A95A0043. REMAND SUPERSEDEAS TO STAY ARBITRATION.**

This appeal challenges the trial court's order compelling arbitration. Appellant has filed a motion for issuance of supersedeas to stay arbitration while its appeal before this Court is pending. Because the failure of the trial court to stay arbitration proceedings may result in the issues raised in the appeal becoming moot, it is hereby ordered that the motion for issuance of supersedeas be granted. See Bartlett v. Dimension Designs, 195 Ga. App. 845, 846-847 (2) (395 SE2d 64) (1990).

The case is hereby remanded to the trial court for the limited purposes of:

- (a) deciding, after hearing argument, whether a supersedeas bond shall be required and the amount and conditions thereof; and
- (b) ordering that the arbitration proceedings be stayed pending the trial court's receipt of remittitur from this Court.
