You must also comply with all the other applicable rules of Court regarding filing with the Court of Appeals of Georgia.

My appeal was denied July 9th, 2012 by the Court of Appeals of Georgia, however it was remanded for resentencing in which I recieved the same sentence of life without parole plus 40 years. I wanted to a motion of reconsideration or a notice of intent to seek certiorari. However I did not recieve my letter informing that my appeal had been denied until July 16th or 17th from my public defender. I only had 10 days from the 9th of July to file a "notice of intent to seek certiorari" so that would only leave me 2 days to file the notice and get it to the Court of Appeals from Hays State Prison which would've been impossible.

I am asking you to please consider my position and give me a timely chance to file a "petition for certiorari" asap. I have proof of the dates in which I recieved my appeal denial. Please reply asap
