- The Notice of Appeal must include a proper Certificate of Service.** A Certificate of Service must show service to the opposing counsel and contain the counsel's full name and complete mailing address. The opposing counsel must actually be served with a copy of your filing.
- An Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus should be filed in the superior court of the county in which you claim you are illegally detained.** An appeal from a denial of an Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus is to the Supreme Court and not the Court of Appeals.
- An Application for Writ of Mandamus should be filed in the superior court of the county official whose conduct you intend to mandate.** An appeal from a denial of an Application for Writ of Mandamus is to the Supreme Court and not the Court of Appeals.
- Your appeal was disposed by opinion (order) on \_\_\_\_\_.** The Court of Appeals \_\_\_\_\_  
divesting this Court of jurisdiction. The case decision is therefore final.





ON 10/29/2011 AT 9:10 A.M., I, LT. RICK ASHLEY, WAS DISPATCHED TO 102 MELISSA DR. IN REFERENCE TO A BURGLARY. I WAS MET BY THE COMPLAINANT, ROGER KELLEY, AND HIS WIFE. THE RESIDENCE WAS HIS DECEASED PARENTS HOME AND HE HAS IT ON THE MARKET TO SELL. HE AND HIS WIFE LIVE AT THEIR HOME IN PELHAM, GA. HE WAS LAST AT THE HOUSE TUESDAY AFTERNOON, 10/25/2011 AT ABOUT 2:00 P.M. AND THEY ARRIVED TODAY, 10/29/2011 TO FIND THE GLASS TO THE REAR DOOR TO THE LAUNDRY ROOM BROKEN. THEY CALLED 911 AT THAT TIME. I HAD HIM OPEN THE BACK DOOR WITH HIS KEY SO I COULD CLEAR THE HOUSE. I DISCOVERED THAT SOMEONE HAD REMOVED ONE OF THE REAR SCREENS TO THE LIVING ROOM IN A ATTEMPT TO RAISE THE WINDOW WHICH WAS LOCKED. THEY TOOK A PIECE OF FIREWOOD FROM A PILE ON THE REAR PATIO AND BROKE THE WINDOW GOING INTO THE LAUNDRY ROOM. A METAL TOWEL CLOTH RACK THAT WAS ATTACHED TO THE BRICK WALL NEXT TO THE SINK WAS THEN USED TO REMOVE THE PLASTIC FRAME TO THE DOOR WINDOW. THE SUSPECT APPARENTLY RECEIVED A CUT CLIMBING INTO THE WINDOW AND THERE WAS A LONG DROP OF BLOOD ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE DOOR. AFTER I CLEARED THE RESIDENCE, I ALLOWED ROGER AND HIS WIFE TO ENTER AND WE WALKED THROUGH AND I HAD THEM POINT OUT TO ME WHAT THEY NOTICED MISSING. THEY FOUND THAT THE 32" MAGNAVOX TV WAS MISSING FROM THE ENTERTAINMENT CENTER IN THE LIVING ROOM AND THAT THE LEXMARK COLOR PRINTER WAS MISSING FORM ONE OF THE BEDROOMS. THEY DISCOVERED THAT A LARGE QUANTITY OF FROZEN MEAT WAS MISSING FROM THE CHEST FREEZER IN THE LAUNDRY ROOM. I FOUND TWO OTHER BLOOD STAINS INSIDE THE HOUSE. ONE IN THE HALLWAY GOING FROM THE LIVING ROOM TO THE HALLWAY AND ONE ON A BEDROOM DOOR COMING OUT OF THE ROOM WHERE THE PRINTER WAS TAKEN. THE BLOOD STAINS WERE ABOUT SHOULDER HEIGHT AND APPEARED TO BE FROM THE SUSPECTS UPPER RIGHT ARM. SEVERAL THINGS WERE DISHEVELED IN THE HOUSE BUT NOTHING ELSE WAS NOTICED TO BE MISSING. THE REASON THE PERSON COULDN'T OPEN THE LAUNDRY ROOM DOOR OR THE GARAGE DOOR FROM THE KITCHEN WAS BECAUSE THE DEAD BOLTS WERE USED AND A KEY IS NEEDED TO OPEN THE DOORS. ROGER HAD THE SLIDING GLASS DOOR FROM THE LIVING ROOM TO THE REAR PATIO LOCKED AND A PIECE OF WOOD WAS ON THE BOTTOM TO KEEP THE SLIDING DOOR FROM OPENING. THE PERSONS WHO ENTERED THE HOUSE LEFT THROUGH THIS SLIDING DOOR WITH THE TV AND PRINTER AFTER REMOVING THE BLOCK OF WOOD. THEY THEN WENT OUT THE SCREEN DOOR THAT WAS LOCKED ON THE PATIO, LEAVING THE SCREEN DOOR PARTIALLY OPEN. THERE ARE TWO SCREEN DOORS TO THE REAR PATIO WHICH IS SCREENED IN. ONE IS ALWAYS LOCKED AND THE OTHER IS UNLOCKED. ONCE INSIDE THE SCREENED PATIO, ENTRY IS THEN MADE THROUGH THE LAUNDRY ROOM. ROGER KELLEY WAS NOT ABLE TO PROVIDE MODEL NUMBERS OR SERIAL NUMBERS OF THE T.V. OR PRINTER. I CALLED THE ON CALL INVESTIGATOR, TERRY PHILLIPS AND HE CAME AND PROCESSED THE SCENE FOR LATENT PRINTS AND COLLECTED SAMPLES OF THE BLOOD ON THE DOORS AND WALL FOR ANALYSIS.
