AMENDED MOTION OF RECONSIDERATION

Now Comes the defendant in The Above styled action with his Motion in Amended ~~and~~ Motion of Reconsideration before this Honorable Appeals Court of Georgia as follows:

Alander Crapps the defendant was arrested and indicted and then convicted for violation of a violation of his bond condition from DeKalb County for family violence [WARRANT # 12-W-002842, CASE # - 12-C-53638-3A] defendant was acquitted in DeKalb County State Court July 30, 2013 but, was convicted in Gwinnett County with this evidence on October 15, 2012 for Agg. Stalking.

(A). Where Jurisdiction is challenged, it must be proven.... The law requires proof of jurisdiction to appear on record of the Administrative Agency and all administrative proceedings...
