
The Return Notice dated December 29, 2014 was sent to you in error. The above three appeals are docketed in this Court in your name.

I write in reference to the above entitled and numbered case(s) in your specific courts.

Due to circumstances and events, I find myself missing and in need of vital portions of the case record.

Although previous counsel(s) representation has been terminated, the trial court clerk has forwarded documents and the court's rulings/orders made upon prose pleadings, to previous counsel instead of me.
