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STATEMENTS OF VICTIMS

On 4/17/2012 Victim Mario Woods calls police to Seldon Park. Once police arrive to Seldon Park, Mario Woods advises police that his son Jake Woods lured his mother from the house to so he could remove / take property from the home to give to people threatening his life

See Property in Count six (6) and Counts 11, 12, and 13 of Indictment Exhibit A - "Theft" by Deception

FOR VERIFICATION OF STATEMENT

ON 4/19/2012 Victim MARIO WOODS calls police again making a complaint that he "thought" his wife was kidnapped, then re-tells the story about his son JAKE Woods taken his firearms.

* MARIO Woods also tells police he met with drug dealers on 4/18/2012 and gave them \$ 2,500.00 to receive his property back and he furthermore tells police he receive two (2) of his guns back.

* Key Factor * - It is Illegal to purchase weapons / Firearms off the streets or from anyone that is not a licensed Gun dealer in the United States and the state of Georgia.

So It is clear that Mario Woods admitted that he committed a crime by alleging he illegally purchase firearms of the streets.

*** MAJOR Question - If Mario Woods called police on 4/17/2012 to report what his son JAKE Woods had done. And Mario Woods calls police again on 4/19/2012 to report why he thought his wife was kidnapped, and what

MARIO WOODS calls police on 4/17/2012 reports his son stole fireArms / property , Then again on 4/19/2012 to report his wife , he "thought" his wife was kidnapped, he also reports he gave a subject \$2,500 (us currency) to buy his stolen firearms back on 4/18/2012 , The day after transaction took place "Allegedly". *The reason why mario woods never called police on 4/18/2012 was because Mario's whole motive was getting the so called property / fireArms back. That his son Jake woods had gave in exchange for money that was owed to drug dealers for seized marijuana by Investigators on Blythe Island Ballpark. NOTE: The State District Attorney Liberty M. Haray the prosecutor of the case dismissed Counts 1-5 of the Indictment Number CR1200353-063 against Dante G. Fredrick. District Attorney Liberty M. Haray of Glynn County District Attorneys Office "advised" on "Record" that the state chose to dismiss charges of victim Kim Woods because it was a "QUESTION" in the Time Stamp of the checks that Ms. Woods could not account for. * See Sentencing Transcripts for factual verification. * Basically the State saw a flaw in the statement of Andrea Kim Woods that "Invalidated Probable Cause" because the State knew L.T. David I. Hassler NEVER HAD Probable Cause to charge Dante G. Fredrick and the State never had probable ~~cause~~ cause to prosecute Dante G. Fredrick.

* * Key Factor - It's a "Question" in the statement of Mario Woods. And the "Question" is why didn't Mario Woods call police before or after allege meeting / transaction alleged in Count 8 of Indictment. And why did Mario Woods wait until 4/19/2012 to report this to police? See Case 200601203086 Suppl. ID 496149 for statement.

② This proves Malicious Prosecution by State, violation of 8th, 11, 5, and 14th Constitutional Amendments State and federal. Because the State advise on record they were dismissing charges against Dante G. Fredrick for victim Kim Woods cause of a "Question" in her statement she could not account for, so why didn't the State dismiss the charges for Mario Woods when it's clearly a "Question" in his statement and he admitted to a crime.

③ There is "No Probable Cause" or was "No probable Cause" for police or State to arrest or prosecute Dante G. Fredrick. For Counts 8, 11, 12 Counts for ~~the~~ victim Mario Woods.

STATEMENTS OF VICTIM

JAKE WOODS

On 4/17/2012 Jake woods calls his mother and explains to her that he had taken his dads property and his property out of their home. Jake woods is at "Seldon park" at the time of phone call to mother (Andrea Kim Woods). The mother calls the father and Mario Woods goes to Seldon park. Once Mario Woods arrives at "Seldon park" Jake woods explain to his father what he had done. Mario woods then calls and makes Jake woods tell police what had taken place.

Jake woods begins to tell police that a few weeks earlier him and some friends was arrested at blythe Island Ball park and Drugs was seized by police. Because Jake woods was a minor his parents were called and he was released to his parents.

(1st) Story JAKE Woods gives police - Once his mother exited the house after he called her and told her he had a flat tire at Glynn Academy High School. He goes into the residence and takes property belonging to his father Mario woods. Jake woods then begin to tell police that he received a phone call from a subject name "Key" advising him that he owes 2,000 for the drugs that had been seized by police. Jake woods tells Police he met with "Key" at a "carwash" and "Key"

showed him pictures of his girlfriend and family.

Jake woods advises that he offers property to pay debt that he owes from prior drug deal. This is what leads up to Jake woods luring his mother from the home and taking property.

2nd Story Jake woods gives police - Is that he left the house and turned over all property he had taken to "Keys Vehicle" Jake tells police he and "Key" (suspect) put the property in "Keys" vehicle at Mango's Grill Located at 131 Altama Connector Brunswick GA.

NOTE: L.T. DAVID I. HASSLER made a personal oath to this in warrant Affidavit.

3rd Story Jake woods gives police - Jake advises police he turned over firearms and property at "Seldon Park" and then waited for hours and then call "Key" and that "Key" told him to come to the King and Prince Hotel. He then drives to the hotel where he sits for hours then he said Key calls and says meet him at "Seldon Park" Jake drives to Seldon Park where he sits for hours Unable to reach Key and that's when he calls his mother and his father Mario woods Arrives and calls police.

Note: From investigation of case file G01203086 L.T. David I. HASSLER was attempting to set up a "Sting-Operation" By telling Jake woods to place a call to (suspect) "Key". However the Suspect told Jake woods that whatever he had going on was between him and Danny. Also JAKE woods did tell police of a drug dealer name Danny.

Now Dante G. Fredrick will present his "Theory" of Jake woods

Jake Woods is a young kid experimenting with a grown man's world. See the Streets will Swallow you whole if you are not prepared to enter a world you don't know. When you are a child you tend to follow the wrong crowds and get into drugs, sex, money, and you start experiencing the fundamentals of life. We have all once been teenagers. Jake woods is not a bad person, he is not a criminal. Jake woods chose habits he could not control, made deals with people he should not have. Maybe this experience changed his life. But in the process It has taken almost 4 years of Dante G. Fredrick's life. Every Man controls his own destiny I guess in the end Family is Stronger than Friendship.

Moving Forward..... To the Defense

- ① Jake woods admitted to several felony's and wasn't charged.
- ② Jake woods gave several different stories to different officers as to where he turned over firearms. ① Mango's Grill ② Seldon park
- ③ Jake woods admitted that he gave all property for money he owed for seized drugs.
- ④ In count 6 of this indictment the state maliciously prosecuted Dante G. Fredrick of a crime they had no probable cause to charge him for. It charges no crime.
- ⑤ Count 6 Theft by deception victim Jake woods Charges no crime or does it carry probable cause.

Now Dante G. Fredrick has shown the court that the state had no probable cause to charge or prosecute or to arrest, and even after arrest, prosecution and conviction, that state still failed to convict Dante G. Fredrick of a crime. Count 6 & 8 does not charge a crime, Count 8 has a "Imputed Allegation from Count 6 and all convictions merge by a matter of fact and law violation of the 5th Amendment and O.C.G.A 16-1-7(A) *without Count 6 & 8, counts 11, 12, and 13 are insufficient*

Now DANTE G. FREDRICK will continue to show the court the complete MALFEASANCE In this case.....

FootNOTE: Dante G. Fredrick wants to make me aware that his Indictment was a 14 Count Indictment and that Dante G. Fredrick was convicted of counts 6, 8, 11, 12, and 13. Dante G. Fredrick has shown the court that the state had no Probable Cause to arrest or prosecute or convict. Now Dante G. Fredrick will show why "Count 6 & 8 Charges no crime". An Indictment count that does not recite the statutory language from the code, must recite every essential element of the crime charged. This means Dante G. Fredrick is "actual innocent" of all convictions counts 6, 8, 11, 12, and 13, and dismissed count 14.

STATEMENT OF ANDREA Kim woods

On 4/19/2012 Mario woods calls police and makes a complaint that he thought that his wife had been kidnapped. While Mario woods is with police Ms. Woods calls his cell phone. It is determined that Ms. woods is home safe and not kidnapped or in any danger. Police respond to 111 winton DR. the Home of ANDREA Kim woods. Once police arrive

to the home of Ms. woods she is questioned about was she kidnapped or has any harm been done to her. In the safety of police and her husband, Ms. woods simply tells police she was not forced, held against her will, or was she at no time afraid of Dante G. Fredrick!

Ms. woods told police she went and met Dante G. Fredrick willingly and pick him up and that she and him went to handle business and that she was changing out 100.00 bills for him and thanking him for helping her son. She told police she was upset cause she could not meet Dante G. Fredrick

Case she was with police. See Case ID: G01203086

Suppl. ID: 496149 Now where did Dante G. Fredrick commit any crime? 5 DAYS LATER DANTE G. FREDRICK is charged with 2⁺ Arm robbery, kidnapping, 2⁺ Robbery

Counts 1-5 of Indictment.

Theory of Ms. Woods

Ms. Woods cared more about her child than material property. Ms. Woods had prior attachments to Dante G. Fredrick in the past. She knew Dante G. Fredrick was street connected and that he also knew Danny. She also knew her son had habits and was dealing in the streets because her and Jake both held secrets of each other. Ms. Woods contacted Mr. Fredrick for help and to make problem go away. Ms. Woods saw the only thing her husband cared about was his property. Dante G. Fredrick was with Ms. Woods for almost 3 hours and Ms. Woods never identified Dante G. Fredrick cause she did not want to. She knew he had done nothing wrong. At the end Mario Woods didn't even absolutely identify him. Dante G. Fredrick's story was the same as Ms. Woods.

Defense

① no crime was committed

② police or prosecution never had probable cause

*** ③ Lt. David I. Hassler Alleges he went back 5 DAYS and re-interviewed Ms. Woods. (5 days later) (After Ms. Woods was initially interviewed by Angela Smith #412 and statement was reviewed and approved by SGT. Russell Berger #413 CASE ID: G01203086 Suppl. ID. 496149) And claims Ms. Woods change her story and said that ~~she~~ when she made contact with Dante G. Fredrick that Dante G. Fredrick "TOLD" he had a gun pointed to her side and if he was going to do her a favor she was going to do him a favor!

The state dismissed all counts (1-5) of Indictment of charges against Mr. Dante G. Fredrick and the states reason was because Ms. Woods couldn't account for the 2 hr and 10 minutes between the cashing of the checks, so I rose a "question" in her Statement. So because of this "question" in her Statement But really the state realized that L.T. D.I. HASSLER never had probable cause Dante G. Fredrick with these crimes and tried to dress it up with the "time in between accountability issue" to put Ms. Woods at fault. When Ms. Woods's Statement was made on 4/19/2012 was made before Dante G. Fredrick was ever arrested. L.T. D.I. HASSLER DID NOT Charge Dante G. Fredrick with Arm robbery and Kidnapping until 4/25/2012. The state was well aware of these statements and still chose to "maliciously" prosecute Dante G. the wind shield with a gun pointed at Dante G. Fredrick, while
Eric Melendez was hanging off the side of the vehicle pointing
a taser Eric Melendez forcefully throws Dante G. Fredrick to
the ground and restrains him forcefully and hand cuffs him.
THEN ERIC MELENDEZ searches Dante G. Fredrick and
Seizes \$3,194.00 (U.S. currency / property) See TAG #
G01203086436005 or Exhibit C for factual verification

* Definitions of Arrest *

For the common law definition of the word "Arrest" the Georgia
Court of Appeals has stated:

"An arrest is the taking, seizing, or detaining of the
person of another, either by touching or putting hands on him, or by any act
indicating an intention to take such person into custody, and which subjects
such person to the actual control and will of the person making the
arrest. It is sufficient if the arrested person understands that he is
in the power of the one arresting and submits in consequence thereof.
The taking of another into custody for the purpose of investigating an
alleged crime constitutes an arrest (1769 rpt. Boston Beacon Press
1962) IV, 289. The Georgia Supreme Court has concisely said that
"a person is under ^{arrest} whenever his liberty to come and go as he pleases is
restrained, no matter how slight such restraint may be. Terry v. Ohio, 392
U.S. 1, 88 S.Ct. 1868, 20 L.Ed.2d 889 (1968).

Dante G. Fredrick was then held at Gun ~~point~~ point on the ground by officers. While held at Gun point Dante G. Fredrick demanded to see a Criminal arrest warrant and Badges to Identify the 2 armed men as police. They were in a unmark toyota SUV "Green" and did not wear police uniforms and did not announce they were police officers.

Dante G. Fredrick will now show that the officers had no warrants in their possession to show on demand which is required in a lawful warrantless arrest. Officer held Dante G. Fredrick at Gun point on the ground until a "MARK" Glynn County Patrol Unit arrived at the scene / home of Mr. Fredrick. MR. Fredrick was then taken and placed in the back of the patrol car. MR. Fredrick's wife and children was inside the house. It was later determined that Mrs. FREDRICK SIGNED a consent for the residence to be searched. Dante G. Fredrick was transported to Glynn County police station and no weapons was found on Mr. Fredrick, or in the home, or vehicle of Mr. Fredrick. SEE Exhibit D Case IO: G01203086 Suppl: 445945

Procedure for arrest

In situations where a lawful arrest cannot be made without a warrant, the officer should have the warrant in his possession at the time of the arrest or so near at hand that it can be ~~shown~~ exhibited on demand Crocker v. State, 114 GA. App. 492, 494 (1), 151 S.E. 2d 846 (1966), See Adams v. State, 121 GA. 163 (3), 48 S.E. 910 (1904). See Also GA C. J. S. Arrest §§ 46, 47.

" THE First Interview by police "

Once at the police station Dante G. Fredrick is interviewed by Investigator Herdon and L.T. Tom Jump. During Interview Dante G. Fredrick does not lie to police about meeting Kim Woods or helping her son. He was very truthful about the situation. He was very fearful of Danny and ask officers several times about protecting his family. Dante G. Fredrick became so stressed and in a emotional state of mind he tells police he will plead guilty to whatever they wanted him to as long as 24 hour protection was put on his family. Officer ignore Crie for help of Fredricks family just to try to entrap Fredrick to admit to crimes. When officers seen that fredrick would not admit to the entrapment questions that placed him in a cell until L.T. David I. Hassler arrived to interviewed Fredrick after the search of his home. See Interview Case IOB G01203086 Suppl: 497729

Friday, April 20, 2012 at approximately 1300 hours I responded to Cypress Mill Square in reference to a possible kidnapping. Dispatch had previously advised that the complainant, Mario Woods was calling in reference to his wife Kim Woods being missing. Officer F. West and Investigator M. Thomas made several attempts to locate Mrs. Woods between the parking lots of Big Lots and Powerhouse gym. Negative contact was made with Mrs. Woods. I made contact with Mr. Woods via telephone who advised that he was leaving his place of employment at the time.

I asked Mr. Woods if he could tell me why he thought his wife was kidnapped. Mr. Woods stated that the initial incident dated back several weeks ago when his son Jake became involved with some bad people. Mr. Woods said that Jake's life had been threatened by some really bad people and now whole family was in fear for their life. Mr. Woods went on to say that Jake lured his mother out of the house on 4/17/2012 so he could removed the firearms from the home and give to the people that were threatening his life. Mr. Woods stated that he received a call on 4/19/12 from a subject by the name of "Dan" (LNU). Dan told Mr. Woods that he could get his property back for \$2500 and everything would be taken care of. Mr. Woods stated that he met Dan near a dumpster at the Citgo station on Community Road and gave him \$2500. In return Dan gave him two of his firearms back which were a .22 LR with an unknown serial number and 243 bolt action with a serial number of 736737. Dan was traveling in a white, BMW X5 SUV. Mr. Woods stated that a police report had been taken by Lt. Hassler with Glynn County Police in reference to the incident. Mr. Woods said that he spoke with his wife on this date and she told him that she was enroute to meet someone in reference to getting the guns back. Mr. Woods did not know who his wife was going to meet. Mr. Woods stated that he lost contact with his wife and was not able to reach her. I sent Officer West up to the Harold Pate building to retrieve Mrs. Woods' license plate number. Officer West responded back to me and a BOLO was given for Mrs. Woods and her 1996 Lexus. On arrival to the area I met with GBNET Officer 464 (Mike Thomas). Officer 464(Mike Thomas) helped to search the area and locate the complainant Mr. Woods.

The complainant stated Ms. Woods was suppose to meet with drug dealers who had his stolen guns from the above county case number. Mr. Woods said he was worried after about an hour and tried to call her but did not get a response.

While speaking to Mr. Woods about the above case his wife, Ms. Andrea Kim Woods contacted him on his phone. Mr. Woods said Ms. Woods was made to withdraw approximately 11,500 in cash and give to the black male. Mr. Woods also said the black male was with her in her vehicle when she was made to withdraw the money.

It was determined that Ms. Woods was at her house at the time of this call and the county and other GBNET officers would go to her home at 111 Winton Dr. to interview her.

Mr. Woods also stated, he met with a light skin black male yesterday (4-18-2012) at the Citgo at Cypress Mill Rd and Cypress Square at the dumpster. He stated the male said his name was Dan and was driving a white BMW SUV. Mr Woods said he gave Dan 2,500 cash and received two of his guns back. (.22 LR unknown serial number and 243 bolt action serial number 736737)

GBNET and other city investigators went to 111 Winton Dr. and talked to Ms. Woods about today's incident.

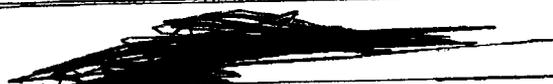

On April 19th, 2012 at approximately 19:20 hours, I (Investigator G. Herndon) of the Glynn County Police Department conducted an interview with a black male that identified himself as Dante G. Fredrick. The interview with Fredrick was conducted in Interview Room #4, where it was audio and video recorded. Fredrick was advised of his rights under the Miranda Decision. Fredrick stated that he understood his rights and signed the Waiver Certificate acknowledging that he understood his rights and would speak to me without an attorney present.

The following is a summary of the interview with Fredrick. It is not verbatim and does not purport the entire interview.

Here is that summary:

I advised Fredrick that he was being questioned about some thefts in taking other peoples money. Fredrick advised that he doesn't take "shit" from people. People make deals and people do slimy ass shit and when shit don't go their way, they want to run to yall.

I asked Fredrick what kind of deals he was referring to? Fredrick then stated that he needed to know what situation I was talking about. I advised him that this had to do with people entrusting him with stuff based on an agreement. Fredrick advised that anything he gets from anyone is given to him. Fredrick then advised that he had video and audio recording of the people giving him stuff. He reiterated that he did not take anything from anyone and that they gave it to him.

I then explained to Fredrick that when he takes someone's money based on a previous agreement and then converts that money into his own funds it is theft by conversion. Fredrick advised that he has a bank account and has plenty of money and that he has a trust fund. He advised that he could show where his money comes from and that I could go to Bank of America and pull up his account and he has money.

I advised Fredrick that if he has money like he says he does, then why was he setting up deals with

out for him. He advised that Blackmon gave him his money card, which was his school money. After that, some stuff went down about some check shit and Fredrick stated that he tried to get him out of that. Fredrick advised that the checks belonged to his grand daddy. Fredrick advised that Blackmon cashed his (Fredrick's) grand daddy's check. Fredrick stated that he told his grand daddy to not lock Blackmon up.

Lt. Jump then asked Fredrick about the recordings and asked if the reason he had these recordings was because he's got people stupid enough to fall for his scams. Fredrick interrupted and stated that he has the recordings because these people are out there dealing and doing fucked up shit and then want to run to the police and say he did something to them. Fredrick advised that he got audio and video because last time he was accused of using a gun and he didn't do anything like that. Lt. Jump advised him that he did not believe him and that he did do something wrong. Lt. Jump advised Fredrick that he scammed the guy out of money the last time. Fredrick advised okay, I did that. Fredrick advised that he can agree with that, but he didn't pull a gun on the guy.

Lt. Jump then asked Fredrick if he was scamming people out of money still? Fredrick advised, "No, ummmmm." Lt. Jump asked Fredrick what he wanted to call it? Fredrick advised, "I'm not gonna say, ummm actually no I havent been scamming people out of money but I've had a couple of situations that wat down to where..." Lt. Jump again asked if Fredrick was talking people into giving him money? Fredrick advised, "No, ummmmmm" and did not seem to know how to reply. Fredrick then stated after a pause "Actually I'm doing pretty good business". Lt. Jump reiterated to Fredrick that he was doing good business by talking people into giving him their money". Fredrick advised, "No sir, I've actually been doing pretty good business." Lt. Jump asked Fredrick what he meant by that. Fredrick stated, "I've been doing really good business. I ain't really been shittin on people".

Lt. Jump asked Fredrick how much money Fredrick made today. Fredrick then stated "To be honest with you, I've been home all day. I came out for a few hours and then went back to the house". Fredrick advised he did come out around 12:00pm and 1:00pm. Lt. Jump asked him what he did when he came out. Fredrick stated that he came out and did what he does. Lt. Jump asked him again what he did when he came out and he said he met a few people and had a few deals going on today.

Lt. Jump asked Fredrick if he went to a bank today and Fredrick advised that he went to three different banks. Fredrick stated that he went to Suntrust, Ameris and Bank of America.

Lt. Jump asked Fredrick what he went to Suntrust for? Fredrick stated that he had to meet someone

He advised that he feels like he's being made to do what he does. I asked Fredrick how they were making him do it? Fredrick advised that he got into some "shit". Fredrick stated "doing a little bit of money". He advised that he got involved with the same dude that "K's" son got tied in with.

Lt. Jump asked Fredrick what he went to the Ameris Bank to meet the lady for again. Fredrick advised that he loaned her son some money to save his ass, because they were "cool". Fredrick stated that he got set up over some bullshit. Fredrick advised that the ladies son owed him \$3,500.00, which he agreed to pay back.
