

I would like to thank you sincerely for responding extra specially quickly in regard to the Dismissals for the cases as styled above, but I need to point out a very serious error which would have to fall in my favor based upon the evidence I am sending you today. I do realize that something of this magnitude could be overlooked quite easily sometimes, so in an abundance of sheer caution, I beckon you to review the evidence as set before you in my newest Motion to Reconsider, and then please resubmit my original Motion to Reconsider based upon that same evidence.

Mr. Castlen, I understand your time is very valuable. I do hope that you are able to understand that mine is equally valuable. I have been fighting this battle since 2009, and I just need a moment of your time to review the receipt from the United States Post Office that I have enclosed for you today. It will show that I earnestly and diligently mailed the package to your office on February 13, 2015. This receipt gave a GUARANTEED date of arrival for February 14, 2015. I do not know when it showed up to your office, but I would like for you to keep the following in mind:

1. I did not receive your orders in my mailbox until February 12, 2015. They were mailed from your office on Feb. 5, 2015. We have had seriously snow troubles and delays here from postal deliveries. However, I made it a point to stay up the entire night of the night I received those orders, and I put them in the mail the VERY NEXT DAY. That is due diligence, sir, and I believe you would have to agree.
2. The deadline is 10 days from the date of the orders which were I assume, filed, and then mailed to me on February 5, 2015. Ten days from that date would give an expiration date of February 15, 2015. As you may be aware, February 15, fell on SUNDAY.
3. Even though I mailed four Motions to your office on February 13, with an expected delivery of February 14, 2015, as you may be aware, February 14, 2015 fell on SATURDAY.
