Part I

Statement of Facts

Jerry L. Howard was found guilty of rape and other crimes, after which he filed a timely motion for new trial. On September 16, 2014, the trial court entered an order denying the motion for new trial. On October 17, 2014, Howard ~~filed~~ pro se notice of Appeal was filed by the Superior Superior Court Clerk office of Chatham County, Georgia, which he sent via U.S. mail.

Appellant then filed an Appellant Brief with the Court of Appeals of Georgia, case no. A15A1456. Which was timely filed by mail rule, Howard's appeal was dismissed for lack of jurisdiction, because the Superior Court of Chatham County, Georgia, stamped upon it that Howard filed his notice of appeal 31 days after entry of the trial court's order. See notice of Appeal post dated October 10, 2015). If clerk of Superior Court filed notice of Appeal on October 17, 2015. Fact, it was in the mail prior to that date.

Enumeration of Errors

1) The appeal court erred by denying Appellant's brief on April 21, 2015, thereby denying Appellant's right to due process and to present his innocence as guaranteed by the Fourteenth Amendment of the United States Constitution.

How else the Superior Court clerk could have filed it on October 17, 2014. Appellant is in prison and had to mail the Notice of Appeal to the Superior Court.

It is respectfully submitted that each issue set forth above demonstrate court made ruling that was unjust and should be righted according to the laws of this state. The mailbox rule. Massaline v. ~~State~~ Williams, 554 S.E.2d 720 And Houston v. Lack, 487 U.S. 266.
