RAY, Judge.

After a jury trial, Elbert Leon Hudson was convicted of two counts of aggravated assault (OCGA § 16-5-21), two counts of attempting to elude a police officer (OCGA § 40-6-395 (b) (5) (A)), and one count each of theft by taking (motor vehicle) (OCGA § 16-8-2) and reckless driving (OCGA § 40-6-390).¹ He appeals from the denial of his motion for a new trial, contending that the evidence was insufficient to support his convictions for the two aggravated assault counts. For the reasons that follow, we affirm.

¹ The trial court granted Hudson's motion for a directed verdict as to one count of driving without a valid license (OCGA §§ 40-5-20, 40-5-29).
