

On May 11, 2015, Appellant filed an “Omnibus Motion: (1) Motion Unseal Any/All Records Regarding Fulton County Cases[;] (2) Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Appellant’s Brief[;] (3) Motion for Extension of Time to File Appellant’s Reply Brief[.]” However, Court of Appeals Rule 41 (b) provides: “All motions and responses to motions shall be filed as separate documents, and shall not be filed as joint, compound or alternative motions.” Accordingly, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to reject the Omnibus Motion.
