(b) Extension of time.







The following order was passed:

**ROGER LEE LARRY v. JAMESTOWN PROPERTIES**

The trial court granted appellee's motion for summary judgment on appellant's complaint for false imprisonment and false arrest and denied appellant's motion to file out-of-time discovery responses. In two notices of appeal, appellant states that jurisdiction is in this Court because it is the highest judicial tribunal. However, the subject matter jurisdiction of this Court is prescribed by the Georgia Constitution of 1983, and none of the bases for this Court's jurisdiction set forth in Article VI, Section VI, Para. II-III are present in this appeal. Therefore, the Court of Appeals has jurisdiction over this appeal, and the Court hereby transfers the case to the Court of Appeals.
