- The Notice of Appeal must include a proper Certificate of Service.** A Certificate of Service must show service to the opposing counsel and contain the counsel's full name and complete mailing address. The opposing counsel must actually be served with a copy of your filing.
- An Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus should be filed in the superior court of the county in which you claim you are illegally detained.** An appeal from a denial of an Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus is to the Supreme Court and not the Court of Appeals.
- An Application for Writ of Mandamus should be filed in the superior court of the county official whose conduct you intend to mandate.** An appeal from a denial of an Application for Writ of Mandamus is to the Supreme Court and not the Court of Appeals.
- Your appeal was disposed by opinion (order) on _____.** The Court of Appeals _____
_____ The remittitur issued on _____
divesting this Court of jurisdiction. The case decision is therefore final.
- Your mailing/documents indicate that you intended to file your papers in another court rather than the Court of Appeals of Georgia.** The address of the Clerk of the _____ is: _____
- If an attorney has been appointed for you and you are concerned with the representation provided by that attorney, you should address that issue to the trial court. NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY

Comes now, Defendant in Case above-styled, by and through undersigned attorney-in-fact, files this Notice of Revocation of Power of Attorney, and shows this Court the following:

1. Plaintiff, STATE OF GEORGIA, GEORGIA STATE, GEORGIA, the STATE or "State" is:

- A. A 'corporate U.S.' state or corporation;
- B. A government de facto.

2. Defendant, JUSTICE S MCCLENDON, JUSTICE SHUNTE MCCLENDON, MCCLENDON JUSTICE SHUNTE, and all variations of spelling and derivatives thereof, D.O.B. 03-20-1982, S.S.N. 260-39-5193 is:

- A. A corporate U.S. State of Georgia corporation.

3. Reference is hereby made to certain "Contract" in the nature of "Power of Attorney" wherein Defendant is grantor and J.H. Buck Beauchamp, State Bar No. 045595, Agis Bray III, State Bar No. 141936, Ingrid P. Driskell, State Bar No. 230445, Robb Hunter, State Bar No. 705122, Marcia G. Shein, State Bar No. 639820, and Elizabeth A. Brandenburg, State Bar No. 467608, Attorneys-at-Law, are agents, authorizing said attorneys to represent Defendant in the Case above-styled, and dated March 2009.

4. All terms of said Contract were NOT disclosed before obtaining Defendant's consent:

A. Said attorneys failed to disclose that they were government agents or rather agents of the Plaintiff in violation of conflict of interest laws as attorneys are not allowed to represent different clients in related matters without the fully informed consent of both clients.

B. Said attorneys failed to disclose that they were Officers of the Court and therefore contracting with them would in effect be contracting with the Court, a third party, in violation of conflict of interest laws as Officers of the Court would now be on both sides of the bench.

C. Said attorneys failed to disclose the "conflicts of interest" aforementioned that would inevitably arise from their consent to represent Defendant in the Case above-styled as said attorneys knew beforehand that "they" i.e. the Trial Judge and the State and Defense counselors, were altogether one-in-the-same being Bar Attorneys, Court Officers and Government Agents.

5. This document acknowledge and constitute notice that Defendant revokes, rescinds and terminates said Contract/Power of Attorney and all authority, rights and power thereto.

Wherefore, ALL contracts imposed on Defendant/ Injured Party under said Contract/Power of Attorney by the Plaintiff or Plaintiff's agents, said Bar Attorneys, this Court or Officers of this Court or any Court of said government de facto, to include, but not limited to, such contracts as Case No. 09 R 661 / 10 R 168 above-styled and Case No. A15A0698 in Georgia Court of Appeals (as all court cases are implied contracts per 1938 Supreme Court ruling on Erie Railroad Co. v. Tompkins); — applications for said attorneys; — entry of plea of not guilty under Case No. 09 R 661 / Case No. 10 R 168 above-styled; — bond for appearance under Case No. 10 R 168 above-styled; — judgment of conviction and sentence under Case No. 10 R 168 above-styled, et. al., are hereby declared null and void without force and effect for failure of full disclosure.

Defendant is Principal of an agency wherein "Justice Shunte," a living soul and de jure free non-corporate American, is the Registered Agent and only Party authorized to negotiate on behalf of said Principal or bring said Principal into contractual relationship with third parties.
