(4) The trial court ignored the material dispute as to whether the Plaintiff is or is not in default on a mortgage Loan. Plaintiff is not in default and has never admitted to borrowing money from JP Morgan Chase Bank.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, and considering the entire record in this case, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court reverse the trial court's rulings. Clearly the higher standard of the Appellee and their attorney's "excusable neglect" was not met. Furthermore, the trial court committed a reversible error by ignoring the Appellant's attempt to object to the ripeness and response error committed and thus not allowing the amendment of his pleading or a proper response. The trial court's order of dismissal with prejudice in this case should not be sustained.
