Dear Clerk;

Last November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014 I had an arrest warrant hearing under my criminal case # 2009-CR-554-2 regarding perjury testimony of the state's lead witness at my trial. The Newton County Superior Court Judge OTT ruled that the false testimony wasn't material. I immediately appealed to your court the following week. I was also denied counsel at this critical point in my case. After 90 days when the appeal still wasn't docketed w/ your Court, I wrote the Newton County Superior Court in March this year and they replied saying "the <sup>Judge</sup> still hasn't ruled on my application of indigency". Another 90 days have passed, and I still don't have an attorney to help me perfect this appeal. I'm being denied access to any legal materials here at Telfair State Prison, and remain Pro-Se. I'm requesting your intervention in this matter, as it is your Court that has jurisdiction over this appeal. I need your assistance in bringing this matter before the court.
