## Statement of Jurisdiction

Pursuant to Article VI, Section V, paragraph III of The Constitution of The State of Georgia, The Court of Appeals shall be the Court of review and shall exercise Appellate Jurisdiction.

## Standard of Review

The standard of Review for seeking discretionary Appellate review of the abuse of discretion by the DeKalb County Superior Court in its denial <Erroneous> of Appellant's "Motion for Entry of a valid Judgment of Sentence", is set forth in O.C.G.A. § 5-6-35, and The Due-process Clause of Both The Georgia and Federal Constitutions.

## Statement of Parties

The Clerk of The DeKalb County Superior Court, and The DeKalb County District Attorney's Office are the Parties in this case before This Honorable Court.

Part I  
Statement of Case

Appellant was arrested on the 5<sup>th</sup> of December, 1995, and charged with robbery, and burglary. Three <3> weeks after Appellant's arrest Appellant was further charged with six <6> more counts of robbery. Appellant was indicted, for the crimes in 1996, and later that very same year <1996> he was reindicted, five <5> counts of burglary, and one <1> count of kid-napping that stemmed from the seven <7> counts of robbery. Defense Attorney told him that she sought bond on Appellant's behalf, but bond was denied for him.

Appellant's trial started on the 6<sup>th</sup> of January, 1997, and ended on the 9<sup>th</sup> of January, 1997, with a guilty verdict and sentence that very same day to a ninety <90> year sentence. The conviction was challenged on direct appeal, filed February, 25<sup>th</sup> 1998, and affirmed by the Georgia Court of Appeals on December, 14 1998. Appellate Counsel never raised a sentence issue, in fact nothing of a sentence was ever mentioned in Appellant's Appeal's Brief.

## Question to The Court

The Question to the Court, is it abuse of discretion for the Lower Court to treat Appellant's pro-se pleading as that by a Licensed and schooled Attorney, and to deny the motion for the Court's Erroneous interpretation; does the Sentencing Court have discretion to correct an arbitrary Sentence that is so overly Excessive and disproportionate that it violates The Due-Process Clause?

### Part 2

#### Enumeration of Errors

- (1) The Court Errored in its interpretation of Appellant's Motion, and abused its discretion when it improperly denied the Said Motion.

Part 3  
Argument and Citation  
of Authority

Enumeration of Error

The Court Errored in its interpretation of Appellant's motion, and abused its discretion when it improperly denied said motion.

(1.)

Was the Court's interpretation of pertinent Law Erroneous?

The Law Specifically states, that "A sentence that is Grossly disproportionate to the Nature of the Crime, and the Circumstances of the defendant, violates the Eighth and the Fourteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution, as well as the Georgia Constitution."

(2)

Appellant's conviction was his first time in the legal system, Appellant had no criminal background before his conviction.

None of the victims in the case suffered any harm, physically nor psychologically, no injury or damage, not one victim was touched, no weapons was used or seen, and it was reported that two hundred and forty eight dollars (\$248.) was taken. Yet Appellant receive the maximum.

In O.C.G.A. section 17-10-6.1 (d) it states "For purposes of this Code section, a first conviction of any serious violent felony means that the person has never been convicted of a serious violent felony under the laws of this State, or of an offense under the laws of any other State, or of the United States, which offense if committed in this State would be a serious violent felony. Conviction of two, or more crimes charged on separate counts of one indictment, or accusations, or in two or more indictment, or accusations consolidated for trial, shall be deemed to be only one conviction.

Appellant now contends that the offenses should be viewed as consolidated and treated as only

One Conviction, warranting a Concurrent Sentence as set forth in O.C.G.A. § 17-10-10.

(4)

Appellant Sentence of ninety <90> years in prison, constitutes a "Recidivist Sentence," Even-though Appellant was not a recidivist, he received recidivist punishment. Under O.C.G.A. Section, 17-10-7, (c) it states that in absence of three <3> prior felony convictions, that Recidivist punishment was not warranted.

Appellant was Convicted for the first time of only one serious violent felony as defined in O.C.G.A. section 17-10-6.1, paragraph (2) through (7) of Subsection (a) of the code, that was, one <1> Count of "Kidnapping" with no injury, and no person under the age of 14, or over the age of 65. In O.C.G.A. section 17-10-7, (a) States "Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this code section, any person Convicted of a felony offense in this State, or having been Convicted Under the Laws of any Other State, or

of The United States of a Crime which if Com-  
-mitted within this State would be a felony and  
Sentence to confinement in a penal institution,  
who shall afterwards commit a felony puni-  
-shable by confinement in a penal institution,  
shall be sentenced to undergo the longest period  
of time prescribed for the punishment of the sub-  
-sequent offense of which he, or she stands  
convicted, provided, that unless otherwise  
provided by law, the "Trial Judge may, in his, or  
her discretion, probate, or suspend the maximum  
sentence prescribed for the offense."

(b)

The law in D. C. G. A. <sup>s</sup> 17-10-6.1, and <sup>s</sup> 17-10-7, pre-  
-scribed "The Maximum Sentence" for Habitual  
offenders. In *Solem v. Helm*, 463 U.S. 277,  
103 S. Ct. 3000, 77 L. Ed. 2d 637, 33 Cr. L. 3120.  
The United States Supreme Court, held that the  
State is justified in punishing a "recidivist  
more severely than it punishes a first  
offender." In *Woodson v. State*, 242 Ga. App.  
67, 530 S.E. 2d 2. (2000), At trial woodson's

previous felony convictions came into question, where he was tried under the "Recidivist Statute." The trial court imposed the maximum sentence for the felonies for which Woodson was convicted of (Burglary, Kidnapping, Rape, Battery, Aggravated Assault with intent to rape, Aggravated Assault with a deadly weapon). He was sentenced to a maximum sentence of Eighty One (81) years.

The sentence imposed by the court in the Woodson's case was warranted considering Woodson's extensive criminal history (background), as well as the hideousness of the crimes for which he was convicted of.

Appellant had no criminal background, and did not committed any hideous acts, where any victims were harmed (injuries). But Appellant still received a more severe punishment than Woodson did. Appellant was incarcerated for twenty (20).

years now. The ninety <90> years sentence imposed on Appellant is the equivalent of a life sentence, in the sense that Appellant will not live to see his maximum release date of 2085, and probably won't live long enough to see his Tentative Parole Month <TPM> release date of 2035. The sentence imposed on Appellant is so overly excessive that it not only shocks the conscience, but it violates the Due-process Clause of both the Georgia and Federal Constitutions. Appellant was a first time offender who hurt no one, and never will.

In *Solem v. Helm*, 463, U.S. 277, 103 S. Ct. 3000, 77 L. Ed. 2d 637, 33 Cr. L. 3220. The Supreme Court also held, as a matter of principle, that a criminal sentence must be proportionate to the crime for which the defendant has been convicted, and that "Reviewing Courts" of course should grant substantial deferences to the broad authority that legislatures necessarily possess in determining the types and limits of punishment for crimes, as well as the discretion that trial

Court's possess in Sentencing Convicted Criminals. A Court's proportionality under the Eighth Amendment should be guided by objective criteria, including (1) the Gravity of the offense, and harshness of the penalty; (2) the sentence imposed on other criminals in the same Jurisdiction; (3) the sentence imposed for commission of the same crimes in other Jurisdiction.

With the severity of the sentence imposed on Appellant, seemed as though Appellant was being penalized for not Pleading Guilty and giving up the right to Appeal. Appellant as a first time offender was not convicted of any hideous crimes. In Dowling v. State, 278 Ga. App. 903, 630 S.E. 2d 143 (2006). Dowling Plead Guilty of hideous offenses like 4, Counts of Aggravated Child molestation, 2, Counts of Rape, 6, Counts of Child molestation, and One Count of Aggravated Sodomy and sentence to 3, consecutive 20, year sentence. Consecutive sentence is warranted in cases such as Dowling v. State, who received less time than Appellant.

In Camaron v. State, 246 Ga. App. 80, 82, (1) 539, S.E. 2d 577, Camaron received a Split Sentence total of 26 years for "Kidnapping, Rape, Aggravated Assault, Aggravated Sexual battery, possession of a Knife during the Commission of a felony, and Sexual battery. The Court said his Sentence were based on the facts and Circumstances of the Case <2000>

In Lambert v. State, 257 Ga. 15, 16 (354 S.E. 2d 144).

The Georgia Supreme Court states that The Eighth Amendment prohibits among other things Cruel and Unusual punishment. This concept embraces not only the prohibition of Torture and other barbarous punishment, but also arbitrary and disproportionate sentence. (i) while

Ordinarily the issue of appropriate punishment is left to the Legislature. The Court have the "POWER" under this Amendment to declare Unconstitutional those punishment which are overly severe, or excessive in proportion to the offense charged.

In Gregg v Georgia, 428 U.S. 153, 96 S. Ct. 2909, 49 L. Ed. 2d 859. The Court held that when a form of punishment in the abstract rather than in the particular is under consideration, the inquiry into excessiveness has two aspects, first the punishment must not involve the unnecessary, and wanton infliction of pain. Second the punishment must not be grossly out of proportion to the severity of the crimes. See also U.S. v Elkins, 885 F. 2d 775 (11<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1989). See Coker v Georgia, 433 U.S. 584, 97 S. Ct. 2861, 53 L. Ed. 2d 982. See U.S. v Kaiser, 545 F. 2d 467 (5<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1977)

(13)

The broad discretion that the Legislature delegated to Judges was for setting appropriate sentence in different offenses and in specific cases. But in doing so, the Judge's discretion must be governed by the "Supremacy Clause" in Article VI <6> clause (2) that states "This Constitution, and the Laws of The United States which shall be made in Pursuance thereof;

and All Treaties made, under the Authority of  
The United States shall be the Supreme Law  
of the Land; and the Judges in Every State  
shall be bound thereby, anything in the  
Constitution, or Laws of any State to the  
contrary notwithstanding."

Appellant now Pray that This Honorable Court  
take into Consideration the Excessiveness  
of the punishment imposed upon him, Appellant  
Ask that this arbitrary overly Excessive Sentence  
be taken off of him by vacating the Sentence, or  
Running the Sentence Concurrently as set forth  
in O. C. G. A. section 17-10-10.



**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR ENTRY OF  
A VALID JUDGMENT OF SENTENCE**

Defendant's Motion for Entry of a Valid Judgment of Sentence (filed May 1, 2015) came regularly before the Court for consideration. Upon review of the pleadings and other matters of record, the Court finds as follows:

Defendant was convicted by a jury on January 9, 1997, and sentenced by this Court to a total of ninety (90) years to serve in custody. His motion for new trial was denied on October 24, 1997. The Georgia Court of Appeals affirmed the conviction and sentence on December 14, 1998. The sentence was then reviewed by the Sentence Review Panel. The sentence was affirmed by the Sentence Review Panel on March 12, 1999.

Defendant alleges that his sentence is void because it is overly severe. A Court may "vacate" a judgment only if the judgment is void because the Court has imposed a sentence that the law does not allow. Harper v. State, 286 Ga. 216 (2009); Crumbley v. State, 261 Ga. 610 (1991). If a sentence is found to be void, the trial court retains jurisdiction to resentence at any time. Williams v. State, 271 Ga. 686 (1999). After review of the sentence and all matters related to this case in the record, this Court finds no error in the sentence and it is one which the law

allows. Therefore, the motion is **DENIED**.




