APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO APPEAL A PROBATION REVOCATION


- To appeal a probation revocation, you will need to file a Discretionary Application with this Court. Rule 31 of the Rules of the Court of Appeals of Georgia describes a Discretionary Application and the items you would need to include with your application.

A Discretionary Application must be filed within 30 days of the stamped filed date on the order that you are appealing and the application must be accompanied by a proper Certificate of Service and a pauper's affidavit or the \$80.00 filing fee. You must also comply with all the other applicable rules of Court regarding filing with the Court of Appeals of Georgia.

Enclosed again is a copy of the Rules of the Court of Appeals for your review.

APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL

- You should direct an inquiry concerning appointment of counsel to the trial court from which you are appealing. This Court cannot appoint counsel for you.

I'm writing to let you know that I did not receive rules of Court regarding filing with the Court of Appeals of Georgia. My native county, Polk, has been moving me around making it hard to maintain contact. I wrote you from Polk County Jail around the 3rd to the 6th of July. I was housed by Polk County in Floyd County Jail on the 6th after I had an accident at the Polk County Jail. I wrote ~~the Court~~ your office again on ~~Wednesday~~ Tuesday July 7th to notify you that I had been moved. I was sent here to ~~FD~~ CP on July 9th and wrote you to let you know of that move as well and to ask you to please send the information I needed here. And I'm still asking you to send me any information you can. I asked the public defender to assist me in filing an appeal before contacting your office but did not and have not received a response. I also file notice of appeal with the sentencing County Superior Court Clerk's office and have those as well. I am also currently awaiting for a

grievance from the General Counsel
of the State Bar of Georgia
because of negligence in responding
to my request, which is more than
reasonable - Also a the code of
Ethics violations that have been on
going from the public defender and
I have continuously notified the
Courts and the State Bar of Georgia.
I assure you my case is legitimate,
but I am operating at a great
disadvantage because of ignorance of
the Rules and laws of Court. Will
you please send me the rules and a
pauper's affidavit and any other
relevant information available.
