THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF GEORGIA COURT OF APPEAL REOPENED AND RESEALED THAT EXPLAINED WHY THE DOCUMENTS WERE ALL MIXED UP, OUT OF THE ORIGINAL ORDER IT WAS PREVIOUSLY SENT. THE COURT SENT THE ENTIRE DOCUMENT RECEIVED ON JUNE 29, 2015 TO BE REARRANGED AND ORDERLY STAPLED. IT WAS DONE AND DEPUTY HALL WAS SUPPOSED TO RESEND IT BACK ON JULY 10, 2015. DESPITE THE FACT THAT THE POSSIBILITY OF BEING FILED IS ~~UP~~ ON THE AIR; IT CAME BACK WITH ONE SET OF THE DOCUMENT MISSING. "REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT." SHE ASSERTED, "WE DON'T CARE WHAT HE SAYS ABOUT US BUT WE CAN'T GO BEFORE THOSE JUSTICES FOR HIM TO MAKE MOCKERY OF US WITH LAWS." THE SAME MS. VAUGHAN WHO SAID BEFORE THE FIRST INCIDENT. Your letter has been received by the Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) and reviewed by my staff.
