BRANCH, Judge.

Edward T. Ridley pled guilty to failure to register as a sex offender. Proceeding pro se, he thereafter filed numerous motions with the trial court including a motion to modify his sentence. Following the denial of that motion Ridley appeals and raises at least 56 assertions of error. Because most of these enumerations are not properly before us or were waived by Ridley's guilty plea and because the remaining enumerations of error have no merit, we affirm.

The record shows that on February 18, 2013, Ridley was indicted in Crisp County for failure to register as a sex offender. The indictment alleged that he had been convicted of the offense of attempted sexual battery in Florida on July 29, 1996; that he was therefore required to register as a sexual offender in Georgia upon moving

to Georgia in October 2003; that on June 1, 2010, he failed to comply with OCGA § 42-1-12 (f)¹ by failing to update his residential address; that a random check of his registered address revealed that he had never resided there with his whereabouts being then unknown;² and that he failed to provide an updated address within 72

¹ OCGA § 42-1-12 (f) (5) provides as follows:

Any sexual offender required to register under this Code section shall:

. . . (5) Update the required registration information with the sheriff of the county in which the sexual offender resides within 72 hours of any change to the required registration information, other than where he or she resides or sleeps if such person is homeless. If the information is the sexual offender's new address, the sexual offender shall give the information regarding the sexual offender's new address to the sheriff of the county in which the sexual offender last registered within 72 hours prior to any change of address and to the sheriff of the county to which the sexual offender is moving within 72 hours prior to establishing such new address.

² Ridley apparently was located in Troy, Alabama, and extradited to Georgia to face charges.
