- An Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus should be filed in the superior court of the county in which you claim you are illegally detained. An appeal from a denial of an Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus is to the Supreme Court and not the Court of Appeals.
- An Application for Writ of Mandamus should be filed in the superior court of the county official whose conduct you intend to mandate. An appeal from a denial of an Application for Writ of Mandamus is to the Supreme Court and not the Court of Appeals.
- Your appeal was disposed by opinion (order) on _____. The Court of Appeals _____ . The remittitur issued on _____ divesting this Court of jurisdiction. The case decision is therefore final.

ORDER

The above Defendant continues to file numerous motions on a weekly basis in the above three cases. The latest are a Motion for Unsupervised Probation, a Motion to Reinstate Bond, an Emergency Motion to Withdraw Plea, Arrest of Judgment for Newly Discovered Evidence, a Motion for Appointment of Counsel, a Motion for Production of Documents, an Emergency Motion for T.R.O. and an Emergency Stay Execution of Sentence and Amended Motion in Arrest of Judgment. This Court has previously considered most, if not all, of the Defendant's arguments, as have the other judges of this circuit and the Georgia Court of Appeals, which just last month rejected some 56 enumerations of error brought by the Defendant in Case No. 13R-149. Nevertheless, this Defendant refuses to accept the rejection of his arguments and continues to file motions which repeat the same arguments. This Court has read and considered the most recent motions filed and denies all of them.

In the event the Defendant files additional motions reiterating the same arguments, this Court will stand on its previous denials and will not individually address any such future motions, which the Court considers to be abusive.
