Dear Bar Member:

You are invited to participate in our 2016 Mass Swearing-In Ceremony to the bars of the Supreme Court of Georgia, the Court of Appeals of Georgia and the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, which is open to all Georgia attorneys regardless of age or admission date.

One ceremony will be held this year for all three courts on **Tuesday, May 3, 2016, at 11 a.m.** at the Supreme Court of Georgia Courtroom on the sixth floor, located in the Judicial Building at 40 Capitol Square SW, Atlanta, GA 30334. Plan to arrive **early** and be **dressed professionally**. The doors close at **11 a.m.** and you will **not be allowed in after this time**. Families are welcome to attend, but must also arrive early and be dressed professionally.

Important Reminders from the YLD Appellate Admissions Committee (AAC)

Questions about each court's application **must** be sent to each court clerk, contact info herein. If you have other questions, please see the FAQ section at the end of this letter.

Your applications will **not** be checked for accuracy, so please double-check before mailing, as incorrect applications will be rejected by the courts. You will **not** receive written or verbal confirmation from the AAC that your application has been received, so please consider sending via certified mail with return receipt or by FedEx with delivery confirmation. You will **not** be told by the AAC if the courts approved or rejected your application. Only the clerk of each respective court can give out that information. Also, the AAC **cannot** sponsor your Supreme Court or Court of Appeals application (but will act as one of two needed sponsors for the N.D. Ga. Application). Make sure you include all necessary checks and **get your application in early**. Finally, you will inform the clerks of both Georgia appellate courts of the date on which you were admitted to practice, into which Superior Court you were admitted and your Georgia Bar number. This information will be required in order for your name to be properly recorded on the roll book of each appellate court. For the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, you must bring your actual Georgia Bar card and driver's license.

Please note: Read the court instructions that follow carefully, because each application is a little different and requires your name to appear according to their particularities.

Supreme Court of Georgia Application Process

1. Click [here](#) for the application. You will need Adobe Acrobat to download the application.
2. Type your Georgia Bar number, Date Admitted to the State Bar of Georgia and Requested Admission Date as May 3, 2016, all found at the top of the application, above the line "To the Honorable Supreme Court of Georgia."
3. Type your Name *as you want it shown on your certificate*, and sign it after you print it. **Application is incomplete if signature line is left blank.**
4. Type your Firm Name and Mailing Address (business address preferred). **Application is incomplete if address is left blank.**
5. Type your Telephone Number and Email Address. **Application is incomplete if left blank.**
6. Type the Georgia Bar Numbers and Names of the certifying attorneys on the application above their respective signatures and secure the endorsers original signature. Please note that the two endorsers **must** be admitted to the Supreme Court, and you may call the Clerk's office at 404-656-3470 to verify the admission status of your sponsoring attorneys. **Applications will be denied if the endorsers are not in good standing.**
7. **Do not** type in the box marked "For Clerk's Office Use Only."
8. Print your application and click [here](#) to pay your \$30 application fee by credit card through the Supreme Court of Georgia's website using PayPal. Look for the drop down menu labeled "May 3, 2016, YLD Mass Swearing In" under the "Choose Admission Ceremony" heading. No checks will be accepted.
9. Send your signed and completed application to Mr. Bryan Schivera, Esq., address on page 5.
10. **Do not** bring your completed application with you to the ceremony. For the Mass Ceremony, all applications and payments **must be received** by Mr. Schivera by **April 1, 2016** (except payment to the Supreme Court is submitted using the above link). All applications brought to the ceremony will be rejected.

Court of Appeals of Georgia Application Process

1. Click here for the application. You will need Adobe Acrobat to download the application.
2. All information except signatures **must be typed** on the application.
3. Type your Georgia Bar Number and the Date Admitted to the State Bar of Georgia on the top of the application, above the line "To the Honorable Court of Appeals of Georgia."
4. Type your full formal name and sign on the line provided after you print the application. If you would like your name to read differently on your certificate, please make a note of it on the application.
5. Type your Firm or Agency Name, Mailing Address (business address preferred), Telephone Number and Email Address.
6. Type the Georgia Bar Numbers and Names of the certifying attorneys on the application above their respective signatures and secure the endorsers original signature. Please note that the two endorsers **must** be admitted to the Court of Appeals, and you may call the Clerk's office at 404-656-3450 to verify the admission status of your sponsoring attorneys.
7. **Do not** type in the box marked "For Clerk's Office Use Only."
8. Print your application and staple a \$30 check made payable to "Clerk, Georgia Court of Appeals" to the back of your application.
9. Send your signed and completed application to Mr. Bryan Schivera, Esq., address on page 5.
10. **Do not** bring your completed application and/or check with you to the ceremony. For the Mass Ceremony, all applications and payments **must** be **received** by Mr. Schivera by **April 1, 2016**. All applications brought to the ceremony will be rejected.

United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia Application Process

1. Click here for the application. You will need Adobe Acrobat to complete this fillable PDF. Complete all required fields, submit the application using the Submit Form button and then Print the resulting form that is displayed on your screen. Required fields (marked with a red asterisk*) must be filed out.
2. You are required to Type your Name as it appears on file with the State Bar of Georgia. Type your First, Middle and Last Name. Type your Generation if you have a suffix like Sr., Jr., II, III, etc. Select Female or Male. Type your Georgia Bar #, Residence Address, City, State, Zip Code, Residence County and Residence Telephone.
3. Type your Law Firm Name, Building/Suite, Firm Street Address, Firm City, State and Zip Code, Firm P.O. Box/Drawer Number, Zip Code, Firm Telephone Number and Your Email Address. Type your General Education Institution, Degree and Year Received. Type your Legal Education Institution, Degree and Year Received. Type the Courts Where You Are Currently Admitted, including the County Superior Court Name and Additional Court Names and Locations.
4. Under Sponsoring Attorneys, **Skip** the Attorney Moving for Admission line (Mr. Bryan Schivera will be moving for your admission en masse so leave that space blank), but type a Second Sponsoring Attorney Name and Bar Number. Sponsoring attorney will be verified for enrollment and good standing with the State Bar of Georgia and the N.D. of Georgia, prior to application approval. You may call the Clerk's Office at 404-215-1600 to verify the admission status of your sponsoring attorney. Please note that you must sign the application twice, with a wet signature.
5. Answer the questions related to Criminal Record, Disciplinary Record and select Atlanta as the office where you would like to appear for admission. Check the box right under Atlanta to signal that you are part of the Mass Admission Ceremony. And check the box acknowledging that you accept the rules and guidelines set forth in the application. The click Submit Form.
6. Print the application and staple a check for \$176 made payable to "Clerk, United States District Court" to your application.
7. Send your signed (wet signature) and completed application to Mr. Bryan Schivera, Esq., address on page 5.
8. Do not bring your completed application and/or check with you to the ceremony. For the Mass Ceremony, all applications and payments **must** be received by Mr. Schivera by **April 1, 2016**. All applications brought to the ceremony will be rejected.



FAQ

1. If I miss out on this mass swearing-in ceremony, won't there be one in the Fall of 2016?

*No, this is the **only opportunity** in 2016 to do the YLD Mass Swearing-In.*

2. I want to be admitted to other courts as well, like the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals, the United States District Court for the Southern District of Georgia and/or Middle District of Georgia. How do I do that?

Those seeking admission to these or any other courts must directly contact the clerks of those Courts for information concerning their admission procedures.

3. What happens if I am not thorough and accurate, and I make a mistake on my application after submitting it, forget to include a check to one or more courts or try to apply after the deadline?

*Be advised that all incorrectly prepared and/or untimely applications will be **rejected by the courts**. Those persons submitting such applications will be precluded from participating in the ceremony unless corrected before the **April 1, 2016 deadline**. Therefore, each applicant must take care to ensure that each application is submitted in accordance with the instructions in this letter.*

4. I know I need to arrive early and that the ceremony starts at 11 a.m., but what if I step outside to use the restroom, etc., and it's 11 a.m. or later? Will the clerk let me back in?

No. That's why you need to arrive early and have family arrive early as well. That way you have time to use the restroom, take a phone call, etc. Once those doors close, you cannot re-enter.

5. I seek admission to one or more, but not all three courts. Do I have to sit through the entire ceremony?

Yes.

6. Do I have to bring a member of the Bar with me to move for my admission?

No, the Chairperson of the Appellate Admissions Committee will move for your admission.

7. What do I do after each ceremony?

After each ceremony, you will line up alphabetically by last name to sign the roll books for each court to receive their certificates. Please make sure to bring your driver's license or some form of photo identification.

Good morning all! I contacted the Freight Depot yesterday about our Spring Mass Swearing In Ceremony and, unfortunately, they are booked for the two dates (May 3 and May 17) that were proposed.

We can either look at new dates for the Depot or look at another venue. I know at one point in time we discussed whether it would be possible to hold the Spring Ceremony in the courtrooms at the Judicial Building. We have done the Fall Ceremony there, but attendance is much lower for the Fall Ceremony. I'm not sure if we can accommodate the crowd we get for Spring, but I'll let Tee and Steve speak to that.
