MACON, Ga., Nov. 6.—(P)—Edward F. Goodrum, 41, attorney, who was active against salary buyers and alleged loan sharks, died Sunday following a cerebral hemorrhage. Mr. Goodrum came here from Albany, where he was secretary to the referee in bankruptcy. He studied law at Mercer University and served overseas during the World War. His body was sent to Columbia, Tenn., Monday for funeral services and interment.




