

G. R. Lilly Succeeds Spurlin as Solicitor In Southern Circuit

Governor Talmadge Thursday announced the appointment of George R. Lilly, of Quitman, as solicitor general of the Southern Judicial Circuit, Superior Court, to succeed the late George C. Spurlin, who died last Saturday.

Lilly is a member of the Quitman law firm of Harrell & Lilly. He is at present City Court solicitor of Quitman, local police judge, chairman of the Brooks County Democratic executive committee, and chairman of the Quitman NRA Board.

The new solicitor is the son of the late Homer F. Lilly, and a nephew of S. J. Faircloth.

His appointment is for the unexpired term of two years.
