*The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:*

**A06A0740. SATISFACTION AND SERVICE HOUSING, INC. v.  
SOUTHTRUST BANK, INC.**

Satisfaction and Service Housing, Inc. filed a notice of appeal from an order of the Superior Court of Bulloch County granting summary judgment to Southtrust Bank, Inc. Satisfaction's notice of appeal requested the Clerk of the Superior Court of Bulloch County to omit nothing from the record in transmitting same to this Court. The notice further specified that a transcript of the proceedings below should also be included in the record transmitted to this Court.

OCGA § 5-6-43 (a) provides that "(w)ithin five days after the date of filing of the transcript of evidence and proceedings by the appellant or appellee, as the case may be, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the trial court to prepare a complete copy of the entire record of the case, omitting only those things designated for omission by the appellant and which were not designated for inclusion by the appellee." It is thus the responsibility of the clerk of the court to prepare the record and transmit it to the appellate court. *Holy Fellowship Church of God in Christ v. First Community Bank*, 242 Ga. App. 400, 402 (530 SE2d 24) (2000).

Here, as stated above, the notice of appeal did not designate any portion of the record to be omitted from the record on appeal. Moreover, the notice of appeal also stated that a transcript would also be forwarded to this Court. Thus, it appears the record forwarded to this Court is incomplete, since it omits plaintiff's response to the motion for summary judgment, and possibly affidavits accompanying that response, as well as other documents of which we may be unaware. Moreover, no transcript has been forwarded to this Court, and the Clerk did not certify that no transcript exists.

Accordingly, this case is REMANDED to the Superior Court of Bulloch County with direction that the entire record be prepared and transmitted to this Court in accordance with OCGA § 5-6-43. This case will again be docketed in this Court at that time, but with a different case number. Appellant need not file another notice of appeal in the case. The superior court is also directed to include a copy of this order in the record transmitted to this Court.

**A06A1702. PATRICE RUSSELL ET AL. v. CEDRIC M. JOHNSON.**

Patrice and George E. Russell, Jr. filed this appeal from the dismissal of their renewal action. Cedric M. Johnson moved to dismiss the appeal. The record as sent, however, contains no order resolving Johnson's motion to dismiss the appeal. This case is therefore REMANDED to the Henry County State Court for resolution of the motion to dismiss the appeal. Should the trial court grant the motion to dismiss the appeal, the Russells may file a notice of appeal within 30 days after entry of that order. *Gilman Paper Co. v. James*, 235 Ga. 348, 349 (219 SE2d 447) (1975). Should the trial court deny the motion to dismiss the appeal, the trial court is ordered to send a copy of that order to this Court so that the case may be re-docketed.
