The Court of Appeals hereby passes the following order:

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The judges of the Court of Appeals of Georgia, having determined that the business of the Court requires the temporary assistance of an additional judge; and,

It appearing the Honorable G. Alan Blackburn, Senior Appellate Court Judge, State of Georgia, has agreed to assist the Court as a Senior Judge pursuant to OCGA §15-3-1(g);

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the Honorable G. Alan Blackburn, Senior Appellate Court Judge, State of Georgia, is assigned to serve as a Senior Judge for the Court of Appeals of Georgia, said service to begin July 1, 2010, and to continue until and through the last day of the September 2010 Term, or until his successor is duly qualified and sworn-in as a judge of the Court of Appeals of Georgia, whichever first occurs.

While the Honorable G. Alan Blackburn is serving as a Senior Judge, he shall be, and by his presence is, vested with all the power and authority as a judge of the Court of Appeals of Georgia, except that he shall have no vote in the Administrative Banc Meetings.
