ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

It appearing the Honorable William LeRoy McMurray, Jr., Senior Appellate Court Judge, State of Georgia, has agreed to assist the Court as a Senior Judge pursuant to OCGA §15-3-1(g);

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the Honorable William LeRoy McMurray, Jr., Senior Appellate Court Judge, State of Georgia, is assigned to serve as a Senior Judge for the Court of Appeals of Georgia, said service to begin August 5, 2010, and to continue until and through the last day of the September 2010 Term, or until a successor to Judge Debra Bernes is duly qualified and sworn-in as a judge of the Court of Appeals of Georgia, whichever first occurs.


