Good Afternoon Mr. Marshall,

I appreciate your willingness to listen and possibly assist us. The Court of Appeals of Georgia would like to use four photographic images in a book to be published by Mercer University Press about the history of the Court from 1906-2006. We already obtained the images and the permission to use them in a DVD that the Court's Technology Staff produced in 2006. We just want to reproduce the images again in the book. They will be appropriately attributed to GSU Library.

The Court of Appeals book is being financed by the Justice Served Inc., a non-profit corporation and a grant from the Tom Watson Brown Foundation. There will be 2500 copies of the book which will go to persons who contributed to last year's centennial celebration and schools and libraries around the state.

I have contacted Mr. Peter Roberts who is the Archivist for the Special Collections & Archives section of the GSU Library about our new request. I asked that the library complete the permission form (example attached to this message) so it could be presented to the publisher of the book. Mr. Roberts sent me a GSU application for permission form which I will complete and return. ## Women Attorneys Will Defend Man At Murder Trial

### Fair Lawyers to Plead the Case of Former Macon Policeman.

Macon, Ga., February 5.—(Special.)—For the first time in the history of Bibb county women lawyers will, on Monday, defend a man charged with murder, when Mrs. Viola Napier, widow of Hendley V. Napier, one of Macon's leading attorneys, and Miss Aline Hardin, cousin of Judge Charles L. Bartlett, will be associated with the defense of a former city detective, W. C. Swift, who, with four other former city detectives, is charged with murdering, in April, 1919, Abram Kimbrell and Phillip Lamar.

It is generally believed that it will be the first time in the history of the state of Georgia that women lawyers have participated in trials where the death penalty is applicable. Other lawyers in the case are W. A. McClellan, leading counsel for the defense, who has associated with Attorney John R. Cooper, T. A. Jacobs and Walter E. Moore. Swift's first trial resulted in a conviction and a life imprisonment sentence, which was set aside by Judge H. A. Mathews, who granted a new trial and later released Swift under \$10,000 bond.

The trial of L. J. Stevens, who is also indicted as a principal in the same killings, and L. S. McLendon, J. E. Bunch and W. G. Evans, charged with being accessories before the fact to the murder of Kimbrell and Lamar, are set for Monday, but are not expected to be reached, as the trial of Swift will probably consume most of the week. Judge John P. Ross is solicitor general in the case.




