

Attached please a revised list of the 2011 Panel Assignments. Because of the sudden and unexpected death of Judge Bernes, I have reconfigured the panels so that we do not have two new judges on the Second Division.

The last time we had three new judges on this Court was in 1999 when Presiding Judge Phipps, Judge Ellington and I came on the Court. Of course at that time, the Court had many more resources, a full competent Central Staff lawyers (10), three floating administrative assistants and a fully staffed clerk's office.

Because of the reduced support staff that we now have, it is going to be critical that the "old" judges do everything they can to help assimilate the new judges and keep our cases moving.

We will begin docketing to 2011 on August 14, 2010. To that end, the clerk's office would like you to have the panel assignments for 2011 no later than July 14.

Since Judge Blackburn will be retiring on June 30, 2010 and since Judge Johnson will not be seeking reelection, you will need to appoint two new presiding judges. Based upon seniority, Presiding Judge Andrews will be the presiding judge of the First Division and Presiding Judge Smith will be the presiding judge of the Second Division. If you hold true to tradition, Presiding Judge Barnes will be the presiding judge of the Third Division and you will be the presiding judge of the Fourth Division. However, you may wish to appoint other judges who are not senior most as you did with Presiding Judge Barnes and Presiding Judge Phipps.

I have attached a list of the Divisions from 2000 through 2010. 2010 has two lists since you denominated new presiding judges during the docket year. The presiding judge is listed first in each of the panels.
